- Donations
 - 1000 ft. Corrugated drainage tile (Bass Unlimited)
 - 700 Concrete blocks (Jones & Sons)
- Enhance 9 acres












Hominy Ridge (2016)

 - Spatterdock tubers transplanted






- 2,060 acres (220 so far)

- Enhance 17 acres







 - Winters 2019 and 2020




