The City of Bloomington is doing park improvements at Griffy Lake that includes a quarter mile multi-use path that will lead to an accessible fishing pier. Additionally, a raised crosswalk will be installed from the parking area to the accessible fishing pier, which will have steps and a ramp down to a large fishing area increasing safety and access for shoreline angling. The project totals over \$1.8 million. They are applying for the Reservoir Fisheries Habitat Partnership/Friends of Reservoirs Small Projects Grant to get fish structures placed by the fishing areas. The Indiana DNR supports this work and actively is managing the fish populations at this lake.
